

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF NEEBING

BY-LAW NUMBER 911-2011

BEING A BY-LAW FOR REGULATING THE DISPOSAL OF LARGE LOADS OF WASTE, INCLUDING ESTABLISHING TIPPING FEES FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF NEEBING WASTE MANAGEMENT SITES.

WHEREAS the Section 391 (1) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001 provides that municipalities may impose fees or charges for services or activities provided by it, and for various other matters;

AND WHEREAS various other statutes that govern municipalities also provide similar authority;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation, acting under these authorities, charges fees for various activities, services, property use and other matters. These fees are adjusted from time to time in accordance with the annual budget process and the evolution of existing processes and services.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF NEEBING ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. INTERPRETATION:

“attendant” means the person(s) employed by the municipality to oversee the operations of the waste management facility when opened.

“garbage” means dry waste other than recyclable materials, organic materials and hazardous waste;

“municipality” means the Corporation of the Municipality of Neebing

“waste” means anything for which the holder has no further use and which the holder has discarded and included, but is not limited to garbage and recyclable material;

“waste management facility” means the Municipality of Neebing facilities known as the Sandhill Site located on Sandhill Road and the Scoble Site located on East Oliver Lake Road.

2. GENERAL PROVISIONS AND PROHIBITIONS:

No person shall, at the waste management facility:

- (a) deposit waste outside the posted hours of operation
- (b) deposit waste or voluntarily recyclable materials at any place other than the respectively designated area
- (c) deposit hazardous waste
- (d) deposit any waste which originated outside the Municipality of Neebing.
- (e) remove or scavenge any deposited waste without prior consent
- (f) remove any items from the trench

3. FEES:

No person shall deposit large amounts of waste at the waste management facility without paying the appropriate fee for that type of vehicle transporting said waste. The Municipal Office will issue a letter to the attendants outlining the type of vehicle and the number of loads that are to be deposited. The attendant will in turn mark the number of loads deposited on the letter and return it to the office for verification. Additional loads will be invoiced and reduced loads will receive a refund. All “Not Sufficient Funds” cheques returned will be subject to an administrative charge and will be recoverable by action or other means open to the municipality.

4. EXEMPTIONS:

Normal daily household waste is exempt from tipping fees.

5. ENFORCEMENT:

- (a) The attendants have the right to refuse to allow a person to dump a large load if they do not have the proper pre-paid letter.
- (b) The person shall receive a written warning on the first occasion of non-compliance.
- (c) The person may be liable to pay a surcharge on each subsequent occasion.

6. SCHEDULES:

7. PENALTY:

Any person who contravenes this by-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction, is liable to a fine or penalty provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, as amended.

8. EFFECTIVE DATE:

This By-law shall come into force and take effect on **MONDAY, JANUARY 2, 2012.**

WASTE MANAGEMENT TIPPING FEES

The fees shall be as follows:

Single Axle 5 Ton Truck	\$ 150.00 per load
Tandem Truck	200.00 per load
Tri-Axle Truck or Larger	300.00 per load
Tandem Axle Trailer over 9'	150.00 per load
Single Axle Trailer over 9'	50.00 per load
Landfill Attendant (call in – after hours)	50.00 per hour

All fees must be pre-paid in advance of dumping.
