

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF NEEBING

BY-LAW NUMBER 917-2012

Being a by-law to set the speed limit of motor vehicles from the statutory speed limits on Boundary Drive in the Municipality of Neebing.

WHEREAS Section 128(2) of the Highway Traffic Act R.S.O. 1990, H.8 and amendments thereto, provides that the Council of a municipality may, for motor vehicles driven on a highway or portion of a highway under its jurisdiction, by by-law prescribe a rate of speed different from the rate set out;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the Municipality of Neebing deems it expedient and in the best interest of the municipality that the speed of motor vehicles on certain highways in the Municipality of Neebing be restricted;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF NEEBING ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. When any highway or portion of highway set out below is marked in compliance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act, the **maximum** rate of speed on Boundary Drive (both east and west under the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Neebing) shall be sixty (60) kilometres per hour.
2. The penalties provided in Section 128 (14) of the Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against this by-law.

This by-law shall come into force and effect once all signs are posted.

ENACTED AND PASSED IN COUNCIL this 25th day of January, 2012, as witnessed by the Corporation seal of the Corporation and the hands of its proper Officers duly authorized in that behalf.
